**5.00 pm "Biodiversity Challenge"** - see our experts face the quizmaster to see who will become BioBlitz Biodiversity Champions 2012.

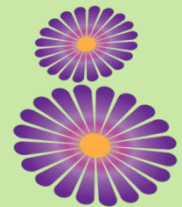
